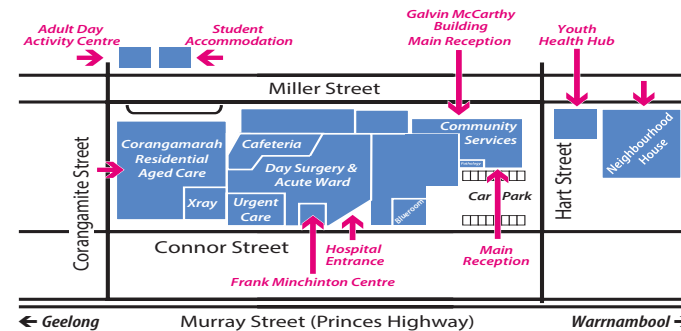

The Orange Door

- The Orange Door is a new way to access services for women, children and young people who are experiencing family violence **or** families who maybe concerned about the development or wellbeing of their children. The Orange Door will provide services to ensure safety, support and information.
- Works with local Aboriginal services and communities, multicultural services, LGBTI and disability services to meet the diverse needs of individuals and families.
- Can connect you with services and information, to support families and individuals to keep safe.
- Can provide advice, information, and secondary consultation to professionals.

Contact the Orange Door if:

Somebody close to you is hurting you, controlling you or making you feel afraid, such as your partner, family member, housemate or carer.

You are struggling with parenting due to behavioural issues, developmental concerns, family conflict, illness, grief or isolation.

You are concerned about the wellbeing of an unborn, child or young person.

You are using violence and you want to change your behaviour.



Through referral to the Orange Door vulnerable families are prioritised for the Family Support Program and Women's Violence Support

Family Support Program

- The Aim of the Family Support Program is to enhance children and young people's safety, stability and development by focusing on building the capacity of parents, carers and families to meet their needs.
- A range of services are offered, including family counselling and advice with parenting and managing children's behaviour, group work, mediation and case management.

Women's Family Violence Support

- Includes access to Women's Family Violence support and Counselling Services in both Colac Otway and Corangamite Shires.
