When you arrive

You will need to register on arrival and pay at the reception desk when you leave. In order we ask that you show us your Pension and/or Health Care Card, if you have one. If you receive a service in the community – such as at home– we will send you an invoice at the end of the month.

What you will pay

Co-contributions are based on your income and ability to pay. No one will be excluded from receiving services due to financial hardship.

How we can help

If you have any concerns about your ability to pay, please talk with your treating health professional who will provide you with information about applying for a reduction/waiver/cap.
